**ORDER**

By motion, the debtor Thomas E. Denmark seeks to reopen his closed Chapter 7 bankruptcy case for the purpose of adding an additional creditor. The reopening of this case for the purpose of scheduling a prepetition debt would not result in any relief to the debtor pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §350(b). Beezley v. California Land Title Company (In re Beezley) 994 F.2d 1433, 1437 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1993) (. . . Beezley's was a no-asset, no-bar-date Chapter 7 proceeding, the amendment of Beezley's schedules, in and of itself, would not possibly had any effect on the status of his obligations to Cal Land. Either the debt was long ago discharged by the operation of §523 and 727 or it was not.)

Therefore, debtor's motion to reopen is ORDERED denied.
