ORDER

A hearing was held on March 15, 1994 in Savannah, Georgia on the motion for stay relief filed by Bird Furniture Company. This separate order is entered in accordance with the Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law which were orally stated by the Court in compliance with Bankruptcy Rule 7052.

It is hereby

ORDERED that the motion for stay relief is denied subject to the requirement that the Debtor provide adequate protection to the movant in the form of monthly payments of Forty-nine Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$49.80), with the first such monthly payment being due and payable on April 15, 1994 and continuing thereafter on a monthly basis until the principal and interest accrued at the contract rate is paid in full; and it is hereby further

ORDERED that the Trustee shall suspend any payment to this creditor until further order of the Court.
