ORDER

The Court has received a letter from Sylvia V. Lamb alleging that this Debtor has failed to comply with the provisions of his confirmed plan. If the allegations of this letter are correct and if the status of the case is correct as reported here, the case should be dismissed with prejudice.

Now, therefore it is hereby

ORDERED that Debtor and his attorney shall appear at a hearing to be held on **Wednesday, October, 11, 2000, at 3:30 p.m.** in the United States Bankruptcy Court, Courtroom #228, U.S. Courthouse, 125 Bull Street, Savannah, Georgia, to show cause, if any they can, why this Chapter 13 case should not be dismissed with prejudice; and it is hereby further

ORDERED that the Bankruptcy Clerk shall be ordered to serve a copy of the letter sent by Sylvia V. Lamb on Debtor and Debtor's counsel for the purpose of advising them of this

communication with the Court; and it is hereby further

ORDERED that this case will not be dismissed for any reason prior to this hearing and that the obligation of Debtor and Debtor's counsel to appear at the hearing will be deemed an order of this Court pursuant to Section 109(g).
