ORDER

On April 8, 1999, an order was entered in this court to Bennett Cabinet Company at 1515 Albany Avenue, Waycross, Georgia 31501 directing that deductions be made from the earnings of the above-named Debtor in the amount of \$250.00 per month or in a lesser amount if the deductions were to be made on a less than monthly basis. A copy of that order is attached to this order as an exhibit. Also attached to this order is a copy of various pay stubs which reflect deductions in the amount of \$518.85.

At a confirmation hearing held on August 25, 1999, the Chapter 13 Trustee reported that these funds had not been remitted by you. As a consequence, the Chapter 13 plan in this case could not be confirmed. Your failure to comply with this order may subject you to sanctions for contempt of court. This order is entered for the purpose of requiring you to show cause at a hearing to explain why you should not be held in contempt of court. In order to avoid the imposition of such sanctions, the full amount of \$518.85 should be remitted to the Chapter 13 Trustee at the address shown on the order in

compliance with the order before the hearing is commenced.

Now, therefore it is hereby

ORDERED that Bennett Cabinet Company through its principal agent, owner or officer shall appear in this Court to show cause why such person, in his or her individual capacity, should not be held in contempt of court for the failure to comply with this Court's order of April 8, 1999, which order required deductions from the Debtor's pay, which deductions were made, and the payment of such deductions by the employer to the Chapter 13 Trustee; and it is hereby further

ORDERED that a hearing for this purpose will be held at **2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 29, 1999**, in the United States Courtroom, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Federal Building, Carswell Street, Waycross, Georgia; and it is hereby further

ORDERED that in the event you fail to remit these funds before the date of that hearing and fail to satisfactorily explain your non-compliance with this order, you may be held in contempt of court, which contempt may include substantial monetary sanctions as well as other provisions.
